INTRODUCTION & OBJECTIVES

We are now in the transition towards endemicity for COVID-19 and business and personal travel has begun tentatively. Governments have begun loosening protocols to encourage more movements of people in the course of re-invigorating business not only within the respective countries but as well as trans-boundary travels. Even before the pandemic there were already travel-related health and safety concerns for business travellers. But now these concerns have been magnified and become even more pertinent. Hence, this Technical Update.

This session hopes to provide a timely reminder about the continued perils faced by the business travellers as well as those who travel for leisure and how to minimise the risks. Amongst the topics that will be covered include assessment of fitness for business travellers as well as those who are being sent to assignments/projects in remote areas where medical facilities may not be easily accessible.

The roles of emergency medical assistance provision will be spelt out while reminding us of the necessary vaccines we should have before travelling. Concerns for the mental health of business travellers as well as assignees will also be considered.
